### Overview of the projects of 2016:

We are waiting for a message from our contact person of the Karmapa Center of Education (KCE) on the progress of this school complex. If there is a new needs, they will once again be provided a donation. The young monks of H.E. Beru Khyentse Rinpoche are still divided over in different monasteries in different locations. The restoration of the monastery in Kathmandu is proceeding slowly, just like the entire reconstruction in Nepal after the large earthquake in 2015. Most boys stay still in Mainpat, India. The English teacher is not yet been deployed. In the course of 2016 our contact person in Bodhgaya moved and we were waiting for a new contact. This was established in December 2016 and now the active search for an English teacher has started. We'll keep you posted of the developments!

### New projects in 2016:

We are in contact with the Buddhist nun, Claudia Butnik, living in Antwerp. She has a project called ' Himalayan Children '. The sponsored children are from poor families in Kathmandu. The sponsor money pays the school fees, school supplies, clothes and any medical care necessary. The HNGF sponsors 2 girls. The parents sign a contract in which they promise not to sell to the girls and that they spend the money on them. There is supervision by a local contact on the right spending of the money. In addition, Claudia is living 4-6 months a year in Kathmandu, where she visits the families frequently. Furthermore, the past year a nice flyer is made which you will find at the end of this letter. We hope to reach more people at courses and other meetings that we want to visit in 2017.

The plan of activities in 2017 is currently being created and will be posted on de website at the end of February, together with the annual financial report 2016 and the 2016 overview. They can be found on the website under News.
