The conditions are better than in Boudhanath (Nepal). With your support a classroom was arranged last year. This year the HNGF sponsored winter clothing. Meanwhile, the 12 boys go to a regular elementary school for general primary education. There they also get English lessons, a nice step ahead.

New project: Rumtek Nunnery in East Sikkim

During the visit to Bodhgaya in 2018 we came into contact with a number of nuns from a monastery in Rumtek (Karma Chokor Denchen Ling). In that monastery 25 nuns are living, aged 9 to 45, under very simple circumstances. The nuns are washing their dirty laundry by hand which takes a lot of time. The foundation aims to contribute to improving the living conditions of children in the Himalayan region by focusing on education and training opportunities. Our attention is focused primarily on children in Nepal and Northern India.

The quality of education offered by local schools is often quite poor, which is why many children cannot read or write. Some of the children in the poorest areas enter a convent to become a monk or nun (sometimes temporarily). But because the monasteries are completely dependent on private donations, living conditions there are also frequently primitive. At times there is no money for clothes, medical care or school supplies.



Education and training are important to help children develop their potential. We intend to promote equal opportunities for both boys **and** girls.
